

## POST 56 AMERICAN LEGION BASEBALL 2020 HEALTH PROTOCOLS

We at Post 56 American Legion Baseball are thankful for the opportunity to participate in the 2020 American Legion Baseball season. However, we recognize that we have an obligation to take efforts to try and keep our players, umpires, coaches and fans safe during baseball games this season. Therefore, Post 56 American Legion Baseball has adopted specific protocols that will be implemented at all facilities where games and practices occur in order to try and protect those in attendance and in an effort to prevent the spread of respiratory diseases like COVID-19. We appreciate all visitors to our baseball facilities cooperating and complying with these protocols when participating and attending games during the 2020 season.

1. We will provide sanitizer in each dugout.
2. We ask that no team use a community water jug or water bottles.
3. No seeds allowed in the dugout.
4. There will be no shaking of hands or other meeting at home plate following the games. Instead, we ask that teams come out of their respective dugouts and acknowledge the opposing team with a gesture of respect.
5. Stadium seating will still be used and available through we ask that people be aware of appropriate social distancing as recommended by Governor Little and the CC. We also ask that any fans sitting around the field be aware of and respect social distancing.
6. Some fields will offer concessions. All volunteers will wear mask and gloves and will follow cleaning and sanitizing protocols as recommended by Eastern Idaho Health Department. We ask that if you are standing in line waiting for concessions that you respect appropriate social distancing.
